Jonathan Perlin, M.D., PhD, MSHA, FACP **Chief Medical Officer and Senior VP of Quality, HCA**

Dr. Jonathan B. Perlin is Chief Medical Officer and Senior Vice President - Quality of Nashville, Tenn.-based HCA, the nation's leading provider of healthcare services. He is responsible for clinical strategy and continually improving performance at HCA's approximately 180 hospitals and 100 outpatient centers.

Before joining HCA in 2006, Dr. Perlin was Under Secretary for Health in the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs. As the senior-most physician in the Federal Government and Chief Executive Officer of the Veterans Health Administration (VHA), Dr. Perlin led the nation's largest integrated health system. A champion for implementation of electronic health records, Dr. Perlin led VHA performance to international and domestic recognition.

He joined VHA in 1999 and served as Chief Quality and Performance Officer, Acting Chief Research and Development Officer, and Deputy Under Secretary for Health. Prior to joining the VHA, he was Medical Director for Quality Improvement at the Medical College of Virginia Hospitals – Virginia Commonwealth University Health System.

Dr. Perlin has served on numerous Boards and Commissions including the National Quality Forum and American Health Information Community and is broadly published in healthcare quality and transformation. A Fellow of the American College of Physicians, Dr. Perlin has a Master's of Science in Health Administration. He received his Ph.D. in pharmacology and toxicology (performing research in molecular neurobiology) with his M.D. as part of the Medical Scientist Training Program at Virginia Commonwealth University's Medical College of Virginia Campus.
